### Mhat do my day fees include?

- Licensed Professional Hunter, Tracker, Skinner and hunting vehicle.
- Accommodation on a full board basis, including: nonalcoholic drinks and table beer/wine.
- Transfer to and from Johannesburg international Airport.
- Transport between and on hunting Area's A and Area's B
- Laundry service (Except on Sundays).
- Field preparation of trophies.
- Licenses for trophies (Permit controlled animals excl).

# Mhat do my day fees not include?

- Hard tack (whiskey, brandy etc)
- Flight to and from Johannesburg International Airport and any national flights from one concession to the next.
- Firearms and ammunition. (Rifle Hire **\$45 /Day**, ammunition at cost price)
- Hotel accommodation before and after the hunt if required.
- Taxidermy, packing, insurance, transport.
- Dipping and shipping of trophies.
- Personal expenses for example Tips, Telephone, Souvenirs etc.
- Tourist Programmes











# Frequently CAsked Questions

#### Where do I land and is it safe?

Your Airport of arrival will be OR Tambo
International Airport in Johannesburg.
South Africa is as safe as anywhere else in
the World. We will pick you up personally
at OR TAMBO International Airport, and
escort you to our lodge. To date, we have
never had an issue with security. No shots
are required and the only one we
recommend may be Tetanus, which you
should keep up to date anywhere.

#### When is the Hunting season?

Our busiest season is late February until the end of October. The Winter months, when it is most pleasant to hunt, are from May through to September. We do hunt year-round, but be ready for the heat from late October until late February. For Bowhunters we recommend the cooler months of June, July, August and September.

#### How do I get my trophies back?

One of our Team members, will skin and salt your capes at the lodge free of charge. Our trusted taxidermy company will then come to the lodge to pick up your trophies to boil the skulls, clean the horns, dip, crate and process the paperwork for export. They will send you an invoice for this 1-2 months later via email. The crate is then picked up by an export agent, and they will send you a quote for shipping back to your country, typically via sea Freight. It is recommend to have an import agent in your home country to receive this crate with your trophies. Upon arrival they can either forward on to your taxidermist, or send the trophies directly to your home via Ground freight.

### When do I pay the balance on the hunt?

We will typically provide you with a final invoice the evening before you depart for home. Any deposits you've made previously will be applied, and you can either pay your balance in Cash, Card machine, PayPal or via an Electronic transfer. (Please note when paying with a debit or credit card we only accept Visa and Mastercard and there is unfortunately an additional 3% card levy added on each transaction. Gratuities are not mandatory, but they are typically expected on an African Safari.
